1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with the prayer to issue directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as both of them were living live-in-relationship.

3. Status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Kapurthala has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today and the same is taken on record.
4. Learned State counsel submits that the statements of parents of petitioner No.1 have been recorded and they have stated that they have no objection to the relationship between the petitioners. Even the statements of the



petitioners have been recorded and they have stated that there is no threat to their lives.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required passed by this Court and the present petition is disposed off, accordingly.
