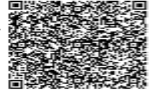

AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioners Muskan and Happy have filed criminal writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty by providing adequate police protection, from private respondent Nos.4 to 9 and with further direction to them not to harass and interfere in their peaceful married life.
2. Notice was issued to the respondents. As a result, detailed status report has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. As per this status report, statements of private respondents Satpal, Rekha Kumari, Sumit, Reeta Kumari and Ashok Kumar have been recorded where they alleged that petitioners are major and they have solemnized marriage with their own wish. They have not harassed or threatened the petitioners. Statements of petitioners were recorded who also confirmed that private



respondents have agreed to their marriage and they do not have any threat perception from anyone and they do not need any protection/security.

3. In view of this status report, present petition seeking protection is rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
