1. Prayer made in the present petition was for regularisation of services as MPHW(F), while in the order dated 18.05.2015, it was recorded by this Court that her services have been regularised w.e.f. 31.03.1993 and all benefits have been granted and in compliance of the same, Director Health Services Haryana had filed an affidavit dated 19.02.2016, relevant para whereof reads thus:

“That however, it was revealed that the service book of the petitioner was not traceable (or lost) so, Civil Surgeon was requested for reconstructing the same. It is pertinent to mention that Civil Surgeon, Panipat submitted the service book vide letter dated 28.01.2016 along with recommendation for granting 1st ACP w.e.f. 01.12.2008. Thereafter, the petitioner has been granted the 1st ACP in scale of Rs.5200-20200+3200 GP w.e.f. 01.12.2008 on completion of 10 years of regular satisfactory service. Pay of the petitioner has also been re-fixed vide order No.E3/GH/P&T/2016/149 dated 04.02.2016 (copy annexed as Annexure R-3/2). Pursuant thereto the petitioner has been released the amount of Rs.3,20,840/- on account of arrears. As such, all financial benefits on account of regularisation of services w.e.f. 31.03.1993 have already been
