DEEPAK SIBAL J. (ORAL)

1. Learned State counsel submits that in the operative part of the impugned judgment no specific direction has been issued to the State to initiate recruitment process against the five backlog posts meant for the handicapped category to be filled up from the respondents and that such direction is only to initiate recruitment process to fill up the said posts but only if they were still vacant and that too as per the provisions of the applicable statute. Therefore, the State, after reserving its right to comply with the afore directions in letter and spirit, does not press the instant appeal.
