1. On 23.05.2024, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in the present application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, preferred by the petitioner-wife, is for transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, filed by the respondent-husband, registered as HMA/1677/2023, pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran.

Notice of motion, returnable for 07.08.2024.

On the oral prayer, liberty is granted to additionally serve the respondent through the counsel representing him before the Family Court.

Reply, if any, be filed before the date fixed with a copy in advance to learned counsel for the petitioner. ”

2. As per office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served, however, he remains unrepresented.

3. It is claimed by the petitioner that the petitions under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and Section 125 Cr.P.C., are already pending at Tarn Taran. The petitioner also has one son aged about 11 years from her first marriage.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the application is allowed.
5. The petition HMA/1677/2023 (Varinder Singh Vs. Rajwant Kaur) presently pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar is transferred to the Court of Competent jurisdiction at Tarn Taran.
6. The Transferor Court is directed to remit the file to the transferee Court, after informing learned counsel representing the respondent for appearing before the transferee Court on 04.10.2024.
