In compliance of the order dated 07.11.2023, learned State counsel has filed affidavit of Rajinder Singh Manhas, PPS, DSP Sub Division Dhar Kalan, District Pathankot today in the Court, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions and a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel opposite.

Learned State counsel, while drawing the attention of this Court to the affidavit, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, has submitted that the petitioner's medical condition is being regularly and routinely monitored and he is on the prescribed medication. In support, learned State counsel has also drawn the attention of this Court to Annexure R-1 which is a report by the Medical Officer of the Sub Jail,

Pathankot, wherein also it stands reflected that the petitioner is being taken for regular medical check up and is on regular medication.

After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to extend the concession of bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner, learned counsel has made a prayer for withdrawal of the instant petition.
