Challenge in the present petition is to the orders dated 20.03.2024
and 25.04.2024 passed by the State Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities,
Punjab.

Reply has been filed by the learned State Counsel on behalf of
respondents No.1 and 2.

Learned Counsel for respondent No.4 namely Anju Sharma
submits that the present petition has become infructuous since the main
complaint has itself been withdrawn by the contesting respondent No.4 from the
