The petitioner has approached this Court seeking a writ of mandamus for directing the respondents to fix the pension of the petitioner as per last pay drawn by him and to release all consequential pensionary benefits including arrears along with interest @ 18% per annum on account of delayed payment.

On receipt of advance copy of writ petition, Mr. Saurav Verma, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the respondents and submits that all the pensionary benefits of the petitioner such as gratuity, leave encashment, etc., have already been released to the petitioner and since the petitioner is yet to sign the pension papers, therefore, the pension has not been released. He further submits that on signing the pension papers by the petitioner, the same shall be released within a period of 02 weeks thereafter.



Let the petitioner visit the office of respondent No.1 on 06.06.2024 at 11:00 AM and complete the necessary formalities by signing the pension papers, etc. and thereafter, within a period of 02 weeks, the necessary benefits shall be released to the petitioner, in accordance with law.

Disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
