The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to the learned trial Court, Chandigarh to decide the criminal complaint filed by petitioner bearing registration No.CRM-18421-2024 dated 17.05.2024 (Annexure P-3) under Section 156 (3) of Cr.P.C. which is now listed for 06.07.2024 for the service of the respondents.

Petitioner in person *inter alia* submits that she has been cheated and harassed physically and sexually by respondent No.1 and she has approached the competent authorities but till date no action has been taken against respondent No.1 who is working in Indian Army. It is further contended that after feeling aggrieved by atrocities committed by respondent No.1, she has approached the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate by filing a petition bearing Crl. Misc. No.2807 of 2023 under Section 156 (3) of Cr.P.C. which was registered on 29.11.2023. Further, on the directions of the learned trial Court, the said complaint was dismissed as withdrawn in view of the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in 'Mrs. Priyanka Srivastava and another Vs. State

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of U.P. and others' AIR 2015 Supreme Court 1758 and liberty was granted to the petitioner to file afresh petition. It is further submitted that the petitioner after withdrawing the earlier complaint, filed fresh complaint under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. which is pending before the learned trial Court for 06.07.2024 and petitioner who is present in person confines her prayer to the limited extent that the concerned jurisdictional Magistrate may be directed to decide the complaint made by the petitioner in a time bound manner or expeditiously as she is running from pillar to post to get justice but nothing till date has come out.

Having heard the petitioner in person and on perusal of the record and also keeping in view the limited prayer made by her, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the concerned jurisdictional Court to decide the complaint filed by the petitioner bearing registration No. CRM-18421-2024 dated 17.05.2024 under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C., expeditiously.

However, nothing expressed herein above would be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case and the jurisdictional Court shall proceed strictly in accordance with law.
