The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to protect the life and property of the petitioner as he is under high risk on account of pursuing sensitive cases in Bargari Sacrilege for the CBI and other agencies.

2. A status report by way of affidavit of Gurpartap Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Rural, District Patiala has been filed on behalf of respondents No.2 to 4.

3. Statement of the petitioner has been recorded by the Police wherein it is specifically said that he has not received any threat at present and does not require any Gunman. He confines his prayer to issuance of Arms License for his personal safety.

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4. Counsel for the respondents contends that there is no application of any nature whatsoever that has been submitted by the petitioner for issuance of any license to the competent authority in a manner known to law.

5. Faced with the above, counsel for the petitioner contends that he does not wish to press the instant writ petition at this stage and prays for liberty that in the event of any fresh threat apprehensions, he may move the authority and file an appropriate petition for seeking such relief.

6. Counsel for the respondents have no objection to the same.

7. Disposed of as not pressed with liberty as aforesaid.
