1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for claiming the following relief:-

"(a) to produce the complete records of the case;
(b) To issue an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release interest @ 9% p.a. to the petitioner on the delayed payment of retiral benefits i.e. Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity, Leave Encashment and GPF etc., which the respondent-department has not paid from the date when it became due, till its realization, as the petitioner is fully eligible and entitled for the same, in view of the judgments passed by this Hon'ble Court."

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3, on instructions, submits that the retiral dues of the petitioner amounting to Rs.18,44,589/- have already been released on 16.09.2019. He further submits that interest @ 6% per annum shall be released on the said amount to the petitioner within a period of two months from
