1. Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No. 74 dated 17.06.2022 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 363 and 366-A of Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of *panchayati* compromise dated 22.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.
2. This Court vide order dated 01.12.2022 had directed the parties to appear before the learned Jurisdictional Magistrate and record their statements in support of the compromise.
3. In compliance of the said order, a report has been received from the concerned jurisdictional Court that the compromise between the parties is genuine and arrived at without any pressure or coercion from anyone.
4. However, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh submits that the present petition has become infructuous, as the

petitioners have been acquitted by the learned trial Court vide judgment dated 27.09.2023.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
