The challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 02.06.2022 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani in FIR No. 59 dated 27.02.2021 under Sections 304-B, 498-A, 328 and 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bhiwani Khera, District Bhiwani, vide which the petitioner has been illegally summoned on the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C filed by the complainant/respondent No.2, who is the father of the deceased.
2. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner today. There was also no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the previous dates of hearing i.e. 10.05.2023 and 27.07.2023.
3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar submits that vide order dated 06.06.2023 the petitioner has been acquitted by the Court of Additional Sessions Judge, Bhiwani. In view of this, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, in case anything

survives, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition within a period of three months from today, if so advised.
