RAJINDER KUMAR V/S BIMLA DEVI AND OTHERS

Present:- Mr. Devender Kumar son of the petitioner in person.

Vide award dated 14.05.2019, Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Bhiwani granted award in favour of respondents No.1 to 5. It was further held that the respondent-Insurance Company will make the payment and then it will recover from Rajender Kumar-petitioner (owner of the vehicle), on the ground that the owner of the offending vehicle was not holding a valid permit at the time of accident. In this revision petition, it is averred that valid permit was available; however, it could not be produced at the relevant time. The documents related to the permit of the offending vehicle were handed over to the opposite counsel by Mr. Devender Kumar son of the petitioner/now deceased to Mr. Nigam Bhardwaj, Advocate for respondent No.7-Insurance Company. Mr. Nigam Bhardwaj, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.7-Insurance Company and he very fairly stated that on verification, the documents were found to be genuine. In view of the same, on instructions from Mr. Amit Vyas, Legal Manager, Mr. Nigam Bhardwaj, Advocate for respondent No.7-Insurance Company, states that the Insurance company will not affect any recovery of the amount awarded by the MACT.

Mr. Devender Kumar, the son of the owner (offending vehicle) namely Mr. Rajender Kumar-petitioner now deceased is present today. It is stated by him that Mr. Rajender Kumar is no more and he is putting in appearance as his legal

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In view of above, this revision petition has become infructuous and disposed of accordingly.

Moreover, in view of above facts, the recovery pending against the owner of the vehicle, if any, shall not be affected.
