Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that under the order passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA-266-2023 dated 12.12.2023, (a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P/2), the petitioner has been reinstated in service but her salary is not being paid to her in accordance with law as she is being paid much less salary as compared to the similarly situated employees, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that upon reinstatement in service, the petitioner is entitled for the grant of salary, which is being given to the other similarly situated employees.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of



submitting a representation dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P/3), which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction be issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P/3) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
