The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.098 dated 07.05.2023 under Sections 15(B)/61/85 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 23.05.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A reply dated 23.07.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 23.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.



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In view of the above, the interim order dated 23.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
