SANJIV BERRY, J. (ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., 1973, petitioner seeks quashing of FIR and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 09.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) executed between the parties. Details of the FIR are as follows:

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise deed dated 09.05.2024 (Annexure P-1), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-JMIC, Rohtak, vide report dated 24.07.2024, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at

between the parties is genuine and without any pressure. The petitioners have



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also deposited costs of Rs.10,000/- and Rs.5,000/- in compliance of orders dated 27.05.2024 and 03.07.2024 respectively.

3. Respondents No. 2 is represented by his counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

4. In view of the report of the Civil Judge (Junior Division)-cum-JMIC, Rohtak, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***“Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543*** and ***“Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping the criminal proceedings pending, since respondent No. 2 has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 170 dated 15.05.2023 under Sections 323, 34, 452, 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Purani Sabji Mandi, Rohtak, and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
