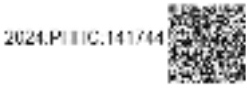

Keeping in view the averments made in the application, the documents are taken on record as Annexures P-1 to P-3 subject to all just exceptions. Exemption is granted as prayed for.

2. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.
3. Disposed of.

Main Case

By way of present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, petitioners seeks quashing of FIR (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the



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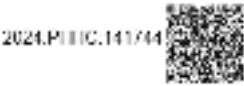
basis of compromise dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties. Details of the FIR are as follows:

2. With the intervention of respectables and elderly people of the society, the parties have arrived at a settlement vide compromise dated 07.05.2024 (Annexure P-2), which is duly signed by them. The matter was referred to the Court below for recording of statements of the parties and to report with respect to genuineness of the compromise arrived at between the parties. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar, Mohali vide report dated 12.09.2024, has apprised this Court that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine and without any pressure. In compliance to the order dated 23.05.2024, an amount of Rs.25000/- has been deposited with the Spinal Rehab Centre, Chandigarh and receipt thereof is annexed with the report.

3. Respondent No. 2 is represented by his counsel and does not oppose the compromise.

4. In view of the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), SAS Nagar, Mohali, and in view of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in “Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another”, 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and “Narinder Singh and Others Vs. State of Punjab and Another”, (2014) 6 SCC 466, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose can be served by keeping with the



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criminal proceedings pending, since the complainant has himself compromised the dispute with the petitioners/ accused persons.

5. In the circumstances, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 59 dated 21.05.2016 registered under Sections 452, 201, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Banur, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise qua the present petitioners.
