1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.54 dated 12.03.2017 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).
2. As per order dated 13.02.2023, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on 22.03.2023 for recording of their statements and the report of the trial Court was sought as regards to the genuineness of the compromise.
3. In pursuance of the said order, report of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kharar dated 05.05.2023 was received to the effect that the complainant did not turn up on 22.03.2023, 23.03.2023 and 27.03.2023 or any other date prior to the report was sent.
4. On 08.02.2024, there was no representation on behalf the

petitioner and the matter was adjourned for today and even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner does not seem interested in pursuing the present petition and even respondent No.2-complainant, who is alleged to have signed the compromise, did not turn up before the trial Court for recording her statement.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.

6. All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
