Prayer in the present revision petition is for setting aside the impugned judgment dated 03.10.2013 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Bilaspur as well as the judgment dated 23.01.2015 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Yamuna Nagar vide which the rent of accommodation allowed to the petitioner deserves to be enhanced

2. In view of the settled law pronounced by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Kunappareddy Vs. Kunappareddy Swarna Kumari (2016) 11 SCC 774*, Full Bench of Madras High Court in *Arul Daniel and others Vs. Suganya, 2022 SCC Online Mad 5435* and by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in *Jaspal Kaur alias Pinki and others Vs. State of Punjab and others in CRM-M-19553-2023* decided on 24.04.2023, the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 cannot be invoked to challenge proceedings emerging out of Protection of Women against Domestic Violence, 2005.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to invoke alternative appropriate remedy on the same cause of action in accordance with law for redressal of grievances raised in the present revision petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
