JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 18.04.2024 whereby Labour Court has stayed transfer of its 19 employees.
2. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that impugned interim order has arisen out of application filed under Section 33A of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 which is still pending before the Labour Court at Chandigarh. They further submit that Labour Court may be directed to decide main application in a time bound manner.
3. This Court is not oblivious of the fact that Labour Court is already burdened with pending cases, however, in the wake of statement

of both sides and without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of with a request to Labour Court to adjudicate the main case within 3 months from today. It is made clear that parties would not seek adjournment.

4. The parties shall complete pleadings within 2 weeks from today before the Labour Court, if not completed as on date.
