By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.780 dated 25.10.2023 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 379B, 427, 506 IPC at Police Station Kundli, District Sonapat, Haryana.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that various co-accused have already been allowed bail either by this Court or by the Court of Sessions.

Attention is drawn towards order dated 10.04.2024 (Annexure P.2) passed by this Court in CRM-M-16603 of 2024, whereby co-accused Mohd. Imran was allowed bail. Another co-accused Vishnu @ Deva was allowed bail on 25.04.2024 by Court of Sessions vide Annexure P.3. Co-accused Imran and Tayub have been allowed bail vide orders passed by the Court of Sessions vide Annexures P.4 and P.5. Another co-accused Aurangzeb @ Sameer was allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 03.05.2024 (Annexure P.6) passed in CRM-M-12581 of 2024.
