JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking setting aside of order dated 27.06.2007 (Annexure P-6) whereby respondent has terminated distributorship agreement dated 21.09.1982. The petitioners are further seeking direction to respondents to re-site the allocation of distributorship.

2. Mr. Raman Sharma, Advocate submits that distributorship agreement was terminated on 27.06.2007 (Annexure P-6) and it was allotted to another candidate. The said candidate is operating since then. The respondent, during the course of inspection, found multiple infirmities in the stock available with the petitioner. The distributorship was cancelled in view of terms and conditions of the distributorship agreement.



3. There was no representation of the petitioners on 26.04.2024 and in the interest of justice, the matter was adjourned for today.
4. Even today, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners. It appears that with the efflux of time, the petitioners have lost their interest to pursue the present petition.
5. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
6. The petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application, if cause survives.
