In the present petition, petitioner is claiming the benefit of regularization of her services under the policy dated 01.10.2003 issued by the respondents as amended time to time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that certain guidelines have been issued by this Court while passing order in **CWP-2158-2020 titled as Ashish Sharma and others vs. State of Haryana and others, decided on 13.03.2024** and prays that keeping in view the said guidelines, the claim of the petitioner for regularization of her services under the policy dated 01.10.2003 be decided.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already served a legal notice dated 12.03.2024 (Annexure P/7) to the respondents, which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction be issued to the



respondents to decide the said legal notice in the light of the guidelines issued by this Court in the case of Ashish Sharma (supra).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, legal notice dated 12.03.2024 (Annexure P/7) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law in the light of judgment passed by this Court in the case of Ashish Sharma (supra). and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
