RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 14.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-12586-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of L.K.Yadav, IPS, Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 14.03.2023 passed in CRM-M-12586-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 20.09.2023 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
