1. Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Rohit Garg, Assistant Commissioner, State Tax, Sri Muktsar Sahib, informs that the services of the petitioner have been regularized on the post of Watchman vide order dated 23.08.2024 by the office of Assistant Commissioner of State Tax, Sri Muktsar Sahib. He further informs that the benefits due to the petitioner shall be released within a period of two weeks from today and in case, the petitioner is entitled for any other consequential benefits, the same shall also be considered and conferred upon him, within the said two weeks, in accordance with law.

2. In view of the aforesaid stand/undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-

stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
