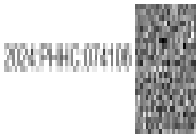
HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J (ORAL)

1. In the present petition, the petitioner is claiming that her late husband was working with respondents but his salary admissible on account of compassionate financial assistance from the date of his death i.e 22.01.2018 till the date of his retirement i.e 31.07.2021 has not been paid and the non release of the salary (compassionate financial assistance) is causing prejudice to the petitioner. Hence, the respondents be directed to release all the salary (compassionate financial assistance) admissible to the late husband of the petitioner for the said period forthwith.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that without raising any grievance before the authorities concerned, the present petition has been



filed and in case the petitioner has any grievance for the non release of the salary (compassionate financial assistance) admissible to for any period, and the same is raised before the authority concerned, an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, any benefit is found admissible to be released to the petitioner, the same will be released, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

5. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to approach respondents with a representation.

6. Ordered accordingly.
