This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying of the order dated 27.08.2019 passed in CWP-22775-2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. Affidavit to this effect has already been filed on behalf of the respondents.
