KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuance of a writ in the nature of '*mandamus*' for passing direction upon the official respondents, to provide protection to them, as petitioner no.1 already being married to respondent no.5, decided to walk out of from the matrimonial relationship, without taking divorce, and is now living in live-in relationship with petitioner no.2.

2. Upon notice issued to the State, a status report, dated 29.05.2024, by way of an affidavit of Sh. Gurpreet Singh, DSP, Sub-Division Mansa, District Mansa, has been filed, today in Court, which is taken on record.

3. At this stage, Mr. R.S.Dhaliwal, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of respondent no.5, through memo of appearance.

4. He categorically informs this Court that in fact, a divorce petition between the parties concerned, is pending consideration before the Family Court concerned.

5. A perusal of the status report (*supra*), it further reflects that no complaint, or any representation has ever been made to the police authorities by the petitioners, expressing any threat perceptions. It is also mentioned in the reply that in case, the petitioners have any threat perceptions, they can approach the police authority concerned, and appropriate action will be taken against the wrongdoers.

6. Considering the status report (*supra*) that at present there is no threat perceptions to the petitioners, no directions is required to be passed. Consequently, the instant petition is **disposed of**. However, liberty granted to the petitioners to approach the appropriate authority concerned, in case they have any threat perceptions.

7. It is expected that the concerned authority will take appropriate action, as per law.
