1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to hand over the investigation in case FIR No.81 dated 29.04.2022 under Sections 420 and 120-B of the IPC registered at Police Station Central Sector 17, Chandigarh, District Chandigarh, to some high rank police officer and to ensure that the investigation is carried out in an independent and impartial manner.

2. Learned Standing counsel for U.T., Chandigarh, at the outset, has submitted that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as challan already stands presented in the present case.

3. In the wake of the submissions made by the learned Standing counsel for U.T., Chandigarh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner does not press the instant petition and instead seeks

liberty to avail alternate remedies as may be available to him under the law.
