'5. That the representation of the petitioner has been examined by SI Jaswinder Singh no. 2164/BTL of Police Station Nathana. Petitioner Veerpal Kaur raised allegation in her representation dated 13.05.2024 that the petitioner got registered a rape case against ASI Gurwinder Singh, a police personnel of District Police, Bathinda and the said rape case is pending for trial. She has been further alleged that due to the registration of the said rape case, Bathinda police is harassing the petitioner as well as her son namely Manpreet Singh. It has been further alleged that on 13.05.2024, her son Manpreet Singh has been picked up by some unknown police personnel's without bearing their name plates on their official dresses and police is also searching her. She has been further alleged that she has a apprehension that she as well as her son may be foisted in a case or they may be eliminated.

6. That the representation of Veerpal Kaur was received in Police Station Nathana and Veerpal Kaur was called and her statement was recorded by SI Jaswinder Singh of Police Station Nathana. She stated that her son Manpreet Singh is doing the business of transport. On 13.05.2024, at 07:00 PM, her son Manpreet Singh was picked up by the police on the basis of a suspicion, so she submitted a representation to Director General of Police, Punjab, Chandigarh through email regarding illegal detention of her son Manpreet Singh. She further alleged that her son Manpreet Singh was released by the police after verifying the facts from him and now her son Manpreet Singh is residing with her. Veerpal Kaur further stated that she does not want to take further action upon her representation. The Translated copy of statement of Veerpal Kaur is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1.



7. That from the inquiry conducted by SI Jaswinder Singh, it is found that Manpreet Singh son of the petitioner Veerpal Kaur has not been picked up by the police nor he has been illegally detained by the police of Police Post Bhucho or by the officials of Police Station Nathana as Manpreet Singh was not wanted in any case or for any inquiry.’

Along with this status report, a copy of statement of Veerpal Kaus is also annexed as Annexure R-1. As per her statement, she wants no further action in the complaint and hence, no further directions are called for.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed being devoid of merit.
