1. Learned State submits that copy of the petition has not been furnished to him, to which learned counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply complete copy of paper book to him during the course of the day.

2. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for directing the official respondents No. 2 and 3 to call the status report on the basis of representations submitted by the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No. 2 to look into the representations (Annexure P-1 to P-5), within a time bound manner.
