In the present petition, grievance being raised by the petitioner is that the petitioner was eligible to be considered for appointment to the post of Kabaddi Coach, which benefit is being denied by the respondents only on the ground that the diploma in sports is not a requisite qualification to be considered for appointment on the said post though, the respondents themselves in the subsequent selection process have already given relaxation qua the said diploma hence, the petitioner is entitled to be considered for the appointment to the post of Kabaddi Coach.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of submitting a representation dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P/14),

which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case, a time bound direction be issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, representation dated 30.04.2024 (Annexure P/14) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to her otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioner will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
