1. The petitioner herein is a defendant in a plaintiff's suit for specific performance of agreement to mortgage. During the course of evidence, the Court has exhibited the documents as Ex.PX and Ex.PY. The petitioner filed an application for removing the aforesaid documents from the record, which has been dismissed by the trial Court on 25.04.2019.

2. This revision petition has been filed to challenge the correctness of such order.

3. On a Court question, the learned counsel representing the petitioner has failed to draw the attention of the Court to any provision in the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 or in the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 to remove the exhibited documents from the record.

4. Hence, no ground for interference is made out against the order passed by the trial Court.

5. Dismissed.
6. However, the Court will be at liberty to decide about the admissibility of the documents at the time of final hearing of the case.
