1. The present petition has been filed for directing the respondents to re-issue the passport bearing No. G5414095 belonging to the petitioner wherein the application bearing Reference No. 22-0007766896 submitted by him has been withheld by the authorities by stating that the petitioner was convicted in one criminal case bearing FIR No. 77 dated 27.08.2013 under Sections 302/307/382/326/325/323/324/148/149 IPC and 25/27/29/54/59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Rajasansi, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that he has instructions to submit that the petitioner be directed to appear before the authorities and only thereafter they shall proceed the matter in accordance with law.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner is not adverse to the said request by the respondents, however, he submits that respondents must

consider that he was convicted in the said FIR more than 5 years ago and
moreso his appeal is pending and has already been granted suspension of
sentence vide P-2 dated 23.09.2021 after undergoing more than 8 years and
5 months out of 10 years sentence awarded to him.

4. In light of the above, the present petition is disposed of at this
stage with direction to the petitioner to apply for his passport by way of
fresh application which shall be looked into by the authorities in accordance
with law after giving an opportunity of hearing to him.

5. Petitioner is also directed to disclose all the relevant material
facts in the application, however, this order shall not be construed as any
permission to the petitioner to leave the country.
