1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 19.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent No. 1 vide which respondent No. 3 has been appointed as an enquiry office to hold departmental enquiry during the pendency of trial in criminal case bearing FIR No. 0020 dated 20.07.2022 registered under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station SVB, Karnal, District State Vigilance Bureau.

2. Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 has submitted that in the present case, all the witnesses which were sought to be examined by the respondents, have already been examined and the enquiry report has already been filed on 12.06.2023 and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition, in case, any cause of action survives.
4. In view of the above, present Civil Writ Petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition, in case, any cause of action survives.
5. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall stand disposed of with the abovesaid order.
