1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to refund the amount of Rs.39,687/- deducted from death-cum-retirement gratuity amount of the petitioner; to calculate the commutation of pension from the date of filing of application for retirement i.e. from the age of 54 and applied the factor 11.73 instead of 11.10 and to pay interest on the delayed payment of G.P. Fund.
2. Since there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
