By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to transfer of investigation of the case from District Nuh to any other District and investigate the FIR No.30 dated 06.02.2024 registered under Section 420, 467, 468, 120-B of IPC at P.S. Nagina, District Nuh, Haryana (Annexure P-1) and for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 5 to decide representations (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner happens to be the complainant in the aforesaid FIR (Annexure P-1) registered way back on 06.02.2024 and despite the documents having been supplied to the investigating agency, the police is not taking any action. He had moved the representation dated 26.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.4, but till date no action thereon has been taken to redress the grievance of the petitioner. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.4- The Inspector General of Police, South Range,

Bewari, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 26.03.2024



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(Annexure P-7) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as well.

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that respondent No.4- The Inspector General of Police, South Range, Rewari, will consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with law.
- 5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4- The Inspector General of Police, South Range, Rewari, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 26.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
- 6. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 7. Disposed of.
