The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 6 for conducting fair and impartial investigation by adding subsequent offences under Section 295-A, 120-B of the IPC as well as other appropriate sections of SCST Act against respondents No.7 to 11, in case FIR No.31 dated 18.05.2022, under Sections 355, 323, 294, 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sudhar, District Ludhiana (Rural).

2. Reply by way of affidavit of Amandeep Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dakha, District Ludhiana (Rural), on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6 has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy of the same has
