After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the higher authorities against the impugned order dated 31.10.2023 (Annexure P-9) so as to convince them that the services rendered by the petitioner were with utmost dedication and there was no default of any manner, which factor has been ignored by the respondents while terminating the service of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that in case, any such representation is filed, the respondents be directed to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, any representation in this regard is received in the office of concerned authorities, the same will be decided by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will also be released to him otherwise due reasons will be mentioned in the speaking order for not accepting the claim of the petitioner for his information and necessary action.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to file afresh,in case grievance still persists.
