RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 19.02.2018 passed in CWP-26887-2016.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Preeti, IAS, Administrator, Haryana Shehri Vikas Pradhikaran, Rohtak, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 19.02.2018 passed in CWP-26887-2016 has been complied with and speaking order dated 14.11.2018 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if they feel aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent.
