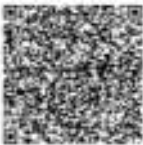

JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in cross case bearing G.D. No.28 dated 28.03.2021 and the challan presented under Sections 323, 294, 302, 3235, 148, 149 IPC in main case having FIR No.42 dated 28.03.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 294, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 27.05.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 27.05.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.



In this view of the matter, interim order dated 27.05.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
