1. Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.40 dated 04.08.2023, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302 and 34 of IPC, 1860 (Section 201 of IPC, 1860 added later on) at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

2. FIR was registered on the information supplied by one Harbans Singh son of Mahender Singh, who happens to be father of the deceased Manjeet Kaur @ Mita. During course of investigation, it is claimed that the prosecuting agency, found that Manjeet Kaur @ Mita was in illicit relationship with Sandeep Singh @ Jugari. He further suffered a statement that he loss of Manjeet Kaur @ Mita was travelling on the motorcycle of the present petitioner who was her masad. It was further claimed by Sandeep Singh @ Jugari that he saw that brother of



and he suspects that the girl has been done away by Balkar Singh.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the main accused Balkar Singh stands admitted to bail vide order dated 15.05.2024 passed by this Court in CRM-M-23534-2024 and further submits that Sandeep Singh @ Jugari appeared as PW-2 and has not supported the version of the prosecution. Reference is being made to his testimony which has been placed on record as Annexure P-3.

4. State counsel is not in a position to dispute the aforesaid facts.

7. Petitioner is behind bars for more than 09 months and 16 days and has no criminal antecedents.

8. In view of above, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

9. Needless to say nothing recorded herein shall be construed to be an expression of an opinion on the merits of the case.
