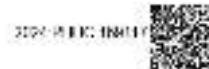

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the benefit of the services rendered by the petitioners in an Government aided institution towards the fixation of their pay and other benefits have not been granted to them by the respondents, which act on the part of the respondents is arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the claim of the petitioners as raised in the present petition is covered by the judgment of this Court in **CWP-4629-2012 titled as, Sunil Kumar Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others decided on 19.02.2018** with connected cases, which judgment has already upheld by the Division bench of this Court.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the claim of the petitioners will be considered in the light of the judgment of this Court in



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Sunil Kumar Sharma (supra) and appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of copy of this order and in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which order will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
