The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.795 dated 09.10.2018, under Sections 302 and 34 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/54 Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal and a further prayer has been made to direct the respondents No.1 to 3 to hand over the investigation of the present case to some SIT or other Crime Branch of the other District.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector Nihal Singh submits that the investigation in the present case has been handed over to SIT, headed by Sh. Vivek Chaudhary, the Deputy Superintendent of Police, State Crime Branch, Gurugram.
