1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 15.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) to the extent he was denied promotion.
2. The petitioner retired from Punjab Police on 30.06.2012 as Inspector. He claims that in view of revision of seniority list, he was entitled to promotion. His juniors have been granted promotion, however, he has been denied on the sole ground that he had already retired on the date of eligibility which is factually incorrect.
3. Mr. Lakshay Bector, Advocate submits that grievance of the petitioner at this stage would be redressed, if respondents are directed to decide his representation dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P-3).
4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and waives service.

6. With the consent of both sides, the matter is taken up for final disposal.

7. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab asserts that competent authority would consider representation dated 28.02.2024 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and pass an appropriate order.

8. In the wake of statement of Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, the present petition stands disposed of. The needful shall be done within a period of 3 months from today.
