1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for the quashing and setting aside of Notice to Vacate dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) and Memorandum/Order dated 14.05.2024 (Annexure P-7) whereby interim punishment has been imposed on to the petitioner, directing him to vacate the residential accommodation provided to him by the respondent Institute by 31.05.2024.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents has submitted that the competent authority had taken a decision to withdraw the vacation notice dated 08.05.2024 (Annexure P-5) keeping in the view the fact that the minor children and wife of the petitioner are also staying with

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the petitioner. It is further submitted that as far as last four lines of first page of the memorandum dated 14.05.2024 noticing the fact of “vacation notice” will have no effect. It is stated that in view of the said stand taken, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the above stand taken by the respondent authorities, the present writ petition be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but the respondents be bound by the said statement. s

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. The respondents would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
