The petitioners seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.25 dated 17.03.2023 registered under Sections 166-A, 420 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Mullanpur, District SAS Nagar, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.05.2024, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 23.05.2024 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
