MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 21 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

2. In compliance of the order dated 25.08.2023, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of an affidavit of Sukhjinder Pal Singh, PPS, DSP Sub Division Attari, District Amritsar today in the Court, which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions and a copy thereof supplied to learned counsel opposite.

3. Learned State counsel has drawn the attention of this Court to paragraph No.4 of the reply and has submitted that since Telecom Companies do not keep data of the call records of more than 2 years,

police have not been able to trace out the origin of the purported threat calls made to the petitioner. However, it has been submitted that the police would ensure the safety of the life and liberty of the petitioner on the basis of threat perception, if any, and then provide him security.

4. In the light of submissions made by learned State counsel and the reply filed on behalf of the State, the instant petition stands disposed of.
