1. The petitioners through the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to grant minimum of regular pay scale including Dearness Allowance in view of judgment dated 20.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-9025-2017 (Annexure P-8).
2. Mr. F.S. Dhillon, Advocate submits that petitioners are working with respondent for more than 10 years and they are not being paid minimum of regular pay scale. In view of judgment dated 20.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-9025 of 2017 (Annexure P-8) and judgment dated 26.02.2024 in CWP-19238 of 2013 (Annexure P-9), petitioners are entitled to minimum of regular pay scale.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service.



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5. With the consent of both the parties, the matter is taken up today itself for final disposal.
6. Learned State counsel submits that Competent Authority would consider claim of the petitioners in the light of afore-cited judgments of this Court.
7. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of.
